Reclaiming the Female Divine Through Stories and Songs

Participants will experience the power of reclaiming multicultural biblical female divine names and images in our faith communities to contribute to healing our wounded world.

Reclaiming Wisdom and other biblical female images of the Divine will contribute to healing our wounded world. Including multicultural female divine names and images in our faith communities affirms the sacred value of females throughout the world who continue to suffer from violence and abuse. The earth, traditionally referred to as feminine, likewise suffers from exploitation. Including female images of God in our sacred stories and songs can make powerful contributions to a more just world. Through exploring stories of clergy and laypeople, participants will confirm the connection between the Female Divine and social justice while discovering practical ways to include Her in our worship services. Through singing hymns that include female images of the Divine, we will feel the liberating power of inclusive liturgy. We will form sacred circles to engage in conversations on expanding divine images to deepen our spiritual experience and contribute to justice and peace.

Presentation length can be adjusted as necessary, from a 1-2 hour presentation; a weekend retreat with 3-4 sessions, 1-2 hours each; or a one day 3-4 hour workshop.
